As part of this, junior scientists can ask alumni about their career paths; alumni in turn have the opportunity to get to know talented junior scientists.

Each event is divided into three parts:

» Kick-off presentation

Kick-off presentation on the general employment situation and possible career paths.

» Speed informing

1 alumnus – 5 junior scientists – 10 minutes
A total of 5 alumni will each give 5 junior scientists 10 minutes for questions and answers.

» Come Together

An opportunity to meet up, ask speakers key questions and pass on contact details.
